Polícies

- Group Minimum: There is no group minimum. The maximum number of participants is 20.
- Reimbursement: We REIMBURSE you the ENTIRE COST OF THE TOUR PACKAGE (less any supplements and gratuities) if you lead your own group through Samson Tours within 2 1/2 years. 1 refund valid per bus. That's one year more than any other company!
- Your Health: All participants <u>must</u> be in good health and walking condition. This program is active and involves a lot of walking over uneven surfaces and climbing stairs. All locations may not be accessible for the disabled. Any condition that may require special accommodation must be reported at the time of your reservation.
- **Deposit (Land & Air):** To ensure your spot on the tour, we request a \$400.00 deposit be paid upon signup. The deposit is fully refundable up to 3 months before departure. After that, the deposit is non-refundable, but transferable to another passenger (provided that the group minimum is met). If the group minimum is not maintained, then the deposit can be used as a future credit with Samson Tours. The deposit can be paid by cash, check, money order, bank transfer, debit or credit card. **Deposit (Air):** If you elect to fly on the group flight, \$150 of your deposit money goes towards airfare. The deposit is fully refundable by the airline up to 3 months before the departure date. After that, airline cancelation fee applies. See the Group Airfare Info handout.
- Payments & Deadlines:
 - November 30 Registration is cut-off.
 - November 30 Final balance is due.
- Group Airfare: You are not required to join the group airfare. We have chosen the flight
 on a variety of parameters: price, overall flight times, and comfort. All passengers
 electing to travel on the group flight will be responsible for any fuel surcharges or tax
 increases that deviate from the budget allocated for flight travel, per the Group Contract.
- **Diversions**: If you book your own airfare, you should do your best to pick an arrival to Israel that is scheduled before the Group Flight and a departure that is scheduled for after or around the time of the Group Flight. If you arrive either before or after the recommended group departure/arrival time, or if your flight is delayed beyond a reasonable waiting period, or if you elect to divert or add-on additional days to the trip, then it is understood that you will arrive at the hotel or to the airport at your own expense.
- Refunds (Land): The following refunds for the land portion (less deposit) of the price will apply to non-insured travelers: Full refund if cancelled 90+ calendar days before

departure. 75% refund if cancelled 89-60 days before departure. 50% refund if cancelled 59-40 days before departure. 25% refund if cancelled 39-25 days before departure. 0% refund if cancelled 25-0 days before departure. **ALL land-payments are transferable to another new passenger up to 40 days before departure**, provided that the group minimum has already been met.

- Passport Requirements: A valid passport, good for 6 additional months from date of return is required of all tour members.
- Travel Insurance Samson Tours does not require travel insurance. It is, however, strongly advised that all travelers equip themselves with a comprehensive travel insurance plan. Samson Tours is a licensed travel insurance wholesaler for Travel Guard Insurance, the world's largest Travel Insurance Provider. Travel insurance can be purchased online through a link on our website individually, or we can provide a discounted group quote if there are 10 or more passengers who wish to purchase.
- **Single Supplement:** For single travelers, a single supplement fee for the hotels is required. This usually amounts to around 90% of the Double Room cost. If a person has ordered a double room and his or her roommate cancels his or her tour, then the individual holding a double room must find a new roommate or pay the single supplement.
- Exchange Rate: The current exchange rate is 3.9 shekels to the dollar. Samson Tours, Inc. reserves the right to charge a supplement to the price if the dollar falls below the 3.4 threshold and our suppliers (hotels, etc.) require it from us. As of August 2012, Samson Tours has never made an exchange rate surcharge.
- **Responsibility** Samson Tours and/or Eitan Chamberlin shall be, in no way, liable or responsible for any personal or property loss, damage or injury howsoever caused.

- Visit Jaffa, the oldest port in the world, where Jonah was swallowed by a whale, and where Peter healed Tabitha.
- Explore Caesarea Herod's Port City and the home of Pontius Pilate (Theatre, Palace, Hippodrome & Aqueduct)

- Welcome "Home" dinner
- Overnight & Dinner: Mediterranean Sea, Ramada Inn & Suites

Friday, February 1st (B/D) – Tour Day # 2

- Stand on Mt. Carmel and see the story of Elijah vs. the prophets of Baal come alive
- Visit Tel Megiddo and lookout over the Valley of Armageddon.
