The kind of experience to expect...

On a scale of 1-10, this is a Level 7-8 or 'busy-paced' Samson tour. Keep in mind that your journey is not a 'vacation' *per se*; it's a pilgrimage to the most sacred land of the Bible. Every step will certainly have its reward, but some days will require a great deal of walking (up to 3 miles per day on average) and sometimes it will require a bit of exertion, some sites up to 100 steps or more (Megiddo, Jerusalem's Old City, etc).

Throughout the nearly 100 sites you will visit throughout the tour, you can expect to learn not only the biblical relevance of each site, but its modern importance as well. Your tour educator will weave into this journey a comprehensive knowledge of history (biblical and modern), archaeology, geology, botany, current affairs and other diverse subjects, as well as introduce you to the many diverse peoples who make up this sacred land, being Jews, Muslims, Druze, Christians, Bedouin and other minority groups.

Policies

Refund & Other Policies (Samson Tours)

- **Group Minimum:** A minimum of 20 participants are required for this tour price. If the number falls below this threshold, we reserve the right to postpone or re-price this offer.
- **Group Maximum:** A maximum of 50 participants will be allowed to join this tour and remain on one bus. Other buses can be added at the group leader's discretion.
- Your Health: All participants <u>must</u> be in good health and walking condition. This program is active and involves a lot of walking over uneven surfaces and climbing stairs. All locations may not be accessible for the disabled. Any condition that may require special accommodation must be reported at the time of your reservation.
- Group Airfare: Samson Tours works alongside the tour leader to find the best airfare and best price for the group. In order to request a group airfare price, there must be at least 10 passengers on the group flight. The airfare will be paid to the airline in full upon their request and subject to their cancellation/refund policies.
- Deposit & Payments for Land & Air: To ensure your spot on the tour, we request a \$300.00 deposit be paid upon signup and no later than November 30th, 2013. The deposit and any payments made are refundable up to 90 days before departure (less any credit card and/or bank fees). After that, the deposit is non-refundable, but can be used as a future credit with Samson Tours. The deposit can be paid by cash, check, money order, bank transfer, debit or credit card.
- Final Payments: The final payment will be made 90 days before departure. Payments made by check or cash will be made in US\$ to Samson Tours, Inc. Payments made by debit or credit card to Samson Tours, Inc. will be charged the full balance. If there are any unpaid fuel surcharges for the group flight, they will be billed to you at cost per the group airline contract either before or after the tour.
- **Diversions**: If you arrive either before or after the recommended group departure/arrival time, or if your flight is delayed beyond a reasonable waiting period, or if you elect to divert or add-on

- additional days to the trip, then it is understood that you will arrive at the hotel or to the airport at your own expense.
- **Refunds (Land):** The following refunds for the **land portion** of the price will apply: Full refund (less deposit, credit card and/or banking fees) if cancelled 90+ calendar days before departure. 75% refund if cancelled 89-60 days before departure. 50% refund if cancelled 59-30 days before departure. 0% refund if cancelled 29 or less days before departure.
- **Refunds** (Air): Per group contract with airline
- **Force Majeure:** If Samson Tours decides to postpone the tour do to political unrest, then your balance will carry over to the new tour dates. Depending on the new dates, there may be an increase in costs, for tours that are rescheduled within 1 year. If you are unable to join the new tour dates, then you will be entitled to a full refund, less the deposit, credit card and/or banking fees. The deposit amount can be applied to any future tour.
- Travel Insurance Samson Tours does not require travel insurance. It is, however, strongly advised that all travelers equip themselves with a comprehensive travel insurance plan through a private carrier, like Travel Guard or through your credit card company. For further details about coverage, download the Group Protection Plan Description of Coverage
- **Single Supplement:** For single travelers, a single supplement fee for the hotels is required. This usually amounts to around 85% of the Double Room cost. If a person has ordered a double room and his or her roommate cancels his or her tour, then the individual holding a double room must find a new roommate or pay the single supplement.
- Exchange Rate: The current exchange rate is 3.6 shekels to the dollar. Samson Tours, Inc. reserves the right to charge a supplement to the price if the dollar falls below the 3.5 threshold. Note: Samson Tours will only do this if the hotels and other agents require it to do so. As of June 2013, we have never yet had to charge an exchange rate surcharge.
- Government Imposed VAT or taxes: Currently there are no VAT taxes on tour packages to Israel. Should such a tax be imposed before the start of the tour, even after 'final payment' has been made, Samson Tours will notify all of its participants in writing. In order to participate in the tour, you will be required to pay all such taxes before the start of the tour.
- **Responsibility** Samson Tours, Inc. and or its agents and representatives shall be, in no way, liable or responsible for any personal or property loss, damage or injury howsoever caused.
- **Update** These policies may be updated from time to time. Upon update, you will be notified by Samson Tours, Inc. or its group leader.

Wednesday, March 19th (B/D)

- Visit the 1st century 'Galilee boat at Ginosar's Yigal Allon Museum
- Set sail on the Sea of Galilee from Ginosar and hear the music of Dani Carmel, a local Messianic.
- Visit Capernaum, mentioned more times in the New Testament than any other city.
- Visit Bethsaida, home to 5 of the 12 disciples
- Drive by the 'cursed city' of Korazin

- Next up is the Mystical City of Safed, one of the Four Holy Cities according to tradition and its Kabalistic studies (the birthplace of Kabala). We will stroll through the narrow, winding alleys; visit some of the beautiful synagogues and browse through the artists' workshops and galleries found in the flourishing "artists quarter".
- End the day at the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered perhaps the most significant sermon ever preached - "The Sermon On The Mount" (Matt. 5)
- Overnight & Dinner: Leonardo Plaza, Tiberias

Thursday, March 20th (B/D)

- Travel towards Nazareth via Cana, where Jesus performed his first miracle, turning water into wine (John 2:1).
- In Nazareth, we will visit the Church of the Annunciation, where it is believed the Angel Gabriel appeared to Mary. We will also visit the site of the Synagogue of Nazareth, where Jesus preached his first sermon.
- See the ancient remains of Beit Shean. In biblical times, King David battled and defeated the Philistines, after he heard the news of the death of King Saul and his son. Visit the bathhouse and the Cardo.
- Drive down the Jordan Valley
- Stop by Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered.
- Experience a float on the unsinkable Dead Sea and cover ourselves with mud.
- Overnight & Dinner: Leonardo Privilege, Dead Sea

Friday, March 21st (B/D)

- Enjoy Breakfast and some leisure time at the Dead Sea
- Checkout at around 10:30
- Climb or cable car up to the top of Masada via the Roman Rampart to see Herod the Great's desert fortress (25-minute hike).
- Tour Masada
- Visit the nature park of Ein Gedi to see the desert ibex, rock hyrax and the cave where David hid from Saul.
- Drive through the Judean Desert to a lookout point over Wadi Kelt and drive along the Road of the Good Samaritan.
- Lookout over the city from Mount Scopus. At this amazing panoramic spot, we'll say the She'hecheyanu (a Jewish blessing for new experiences) as we behold the city of Jerusalem.
- Overnight & Dinner (Jerusalem): Grand Court, Jerusalem

- Walk down the Mount of Olives and visit **Dominus Flevit**, where Jesus wept.
- Enjoy a time of prayer and devotion in a private garden at **Gethsemane**
- Visit the House of Caiphas, where Jesus was held the night of his arrest (Mark 14:53-65).
- Visit the Pools of Bethesda and the Church of St. Anne
- Walk the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher
- See the Damascus Gate, where Stephen was stoned.
- Experience the Garden Tomb (Gordon's Calvary).
- Journey to the Israel Museum's Shrine of the Book & Model of the 2nd
 Temple and also have some time on your own in the new Archaeology wing.
